Every Day

- Music Rotation and Musical CD (005187501)
- CD player
- Music DVD (included with this guide)—Learn the motions that accompany each song.
- TV and DVD player
- Lyrics posters, transparencies (see pages 29-32), or PowerPoint® presentations (available on the music DVD-ROM or *Worship Rally Enhanced CD*)

Day 1

- Strips of paper (1 per child) and marker
- Sticks, rocks, and other creek bank items that can double as musical instruments
- Silly props (wigs, cowboy hats, over-sized belt buckles, sunglasses, boots, plaid shirts, and so forth)
- Several small, nonbreakable mirrors
- Pictures of animals such as bison, pronghorn antelope, bighorn sheep, Great Plains toad, sagebrush lizard, and pika (from the Internet or magazines)
- Heavyweight paper
- Glue

Day 2

- Construction paper cut into 5 fish shapes
- 5 large paper clips
- Dowel rod or stick, yarn, and a magnet
- Washable markers (optional: labels, masking tape, or sticky notes)

Day 3

- Colanders or pie plates with holes punched in the bottom
- Small swimming pool, large bowl, or clear plastic box
- Sand, rice, or pea gravel
- Inexpensive gold coins
- Permanent marker or paint pen

Day 4

- **Two** identical pictures or illustrations each of several heroes: rodeo cowboys, legendary men of the West, cowboy actors or cartoon characters (from the internet or other source) and **one** illustration of Jesus Christ
- Greeting cards
- Pens, markers, or colored pencils
- Names and addresses of people who are in need of encouragement
